PLUS:-

- Humanities History or Geography
- MFL French, Spanish or Urdu



And remember...

If you don't gain a 4 you will have to resit Maths and English at college.

Most colleges will want at least grade 5s if you want to go on to study level 3 courses.

- You find it interesting
- You want to be successful in it
- You have some skill in the subject
- It's right learning style for you
- It is something you might want to study in 6th Form
- It relates to a career you are interested in
- English Baccalaureate (Humanities and Language)
- It's a good reserve choices in case your preferred choice does not run

Reasons for NOT choosing a subject

You want to be with your friends - this is your future not theirs

You like the teacher - there is no guarantee your current teacher will be teaching the GCSE in Y10
